At the 3rd Board Meeting held on 23rd November 2025, we are pleased to announce that the 30th Annual Conference of the Japan Academy for Asian Market Economies (JAFAME) for the 2026 academic year will be held under the unified theme: **"Learning with Asia, Embracing the World: How to Leverage the 'Maturity' of Japanese Companies and Towns"**.

9. Review and Notification of Acceptance

Eligibility for presentation will be determined based on the abstract submitted for review. Applicants will be notified of the results in mid-April 2026. The review criteria align with those for peer review (relevance/contribution, novelty, usefulness, reliability, completeness).

Oral Presentation Awards (Domestic Session/International Session)

An Oral Presentation Award has been established in the 2023 academic year. Awards will be evaluated based on the abstract submitted for review and the content of the presentation delivered on the day. Recipients of the Society Award, Encouragement Award, and Graduate Student Award will be announced at a later date.
